Programs offering

APPROVED COURSEWORK

AMERICAN BUSINESS SCHOOL

Paris, France

Each year over 300 international students attend The American Business School for either the semester, school year or summer through their school exchange programs or direct enrollment. Students who come for a semester choose classes from among subjects such as Humanities, Business Administration, Management, Economics, Marketing or Finance.

Eligibility: Open to all university-level students.

Terms Offered: Fall, Spring and Summer

CIMBA

Paderno del Grappa, Italy

CIMBA is an internationally-recognized academic institute that trains future professional leaders. Through the University of Iowa Tippie College of Business (AACSB accredited), CIMBA offers semester, summer, and graduate study abroad opportunities with rigorous, high quality, professional courses taught in English. Accounting courses are offered.

Eligibility: Open to KU students with sophomore standing by the beginning of the program that have a minimum of 2.5 cumulative GPA. There is no language requirement.

Terms Offered: Fall, Spring and Summer

KOREA UNIVERSITY

Seoul, South Korea

Korea University is one of the best universities in South Korea with a wide range of classes available in English. This is a great summer option for taking major and general education courses.

Eligibility: Completion of one semester at KU and a GPA of 2.5 or higher. There is no language requirement.

Terms Offered: Fall, Spring and Summer

MASARYK UNIVERSITY

Brno, Czech Republic

Founded in 1919, Masaryk University is the second largest higher educational institution in the Czech Republic. University facilities include several new university and faculty libraries, a wide range of sports facilities (gymnasiums, sports fields, a rowing center, indoor and outdoor tennis courts), a botanical garden, and several student clubs at individual faculties.

Eligibility: Open to KU students with sophomore standing by the beginning of the program who have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA. There is no language requirement.

Terms Offered: Fall and Spring

SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT & LOGISTICS IN

PANAMA

Faculty-Led Program in Panama

Gain an understanding of the significance of the Panama Canal, one of the world's most important cargo transit zones and a key element in global trade. Earn 3 hours of business credit. The program includes meetings with supply chain professionals and tours of various key business partner facilities and excursions to an indigenous community.

Eligibility: Applicants must have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

Offered: Winter Break

SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT IN NORTHERN EUROPE

Faculty-Led Program in Germany and the Netherlands

Study supply chain management and logistics in two of Northern Europe's biggest ports - Cologne, Germany and Delft, Netherlands. Earn three hours of business credit through completion of this program. Also includes visits to several cities in Germany and the Netherlands, including Dusseldorf and Dortmund.

Eligibility: Applicants must have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

Offered: Summer

UNIVERSIDAD DE COSTA RICA

San Jose, Costa Rica

The University of Kansas Grupo de Kansas program in San Jose, Costa Rica offers students the opportunity to directly enroll in classes at the Universidad de Costa Rica (UCR). Students will prepare themselves for the semester at UCR by participating in the on-site orientation that provides a well-structured introduction to the country and its culture and history. An Early Start Program prior to the on-site orientation helps students improve their language skills.

Eligibility: Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and at least 4 semesters of college-level Spanish (or the equivalent).

Terms Offered: Fall, Spring and Academic Year

UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG

Hong Kong

Students are fully integrated into the University of Hong Kong and take classes with locals. Students have the option of taking beginner to advanced Mandarin and Cantonese courses.

Eligibility: Open to KU students with sophomore standing by the beginning of the program who have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. There is no language requirement.

Terms Offered: Fall and Spring

PROGRAMS OPTIONS CONT.

UNIVERSITY OF HULL

Hull, England

Students at the University of Hull can take advantage of easy access to a spectacular coastline and some of the most beautiful open spaces in the UK such as the Yorkshire Wolds, the Plain of Holderness, and the North York Moors National Park, not to mention the many historic towns and cities nearby such as Pickering, Helmsley, Driffield, Beverly and York. Take classes in the Business Core as well as the Liberal Arts.

Eligibility: Open to KU students who have achieved junior status by the beginning of the program, and have a cumulative GPA of 2.8.

Terms Offered: Spring

UNIVERSITY OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS & ECON.

Beijing, China

The University of International Business and Economics (UIBE) was founded in 1951 and is recognized as one of China's leading universities in the studies of business and finance. UIBE has a total enrollment of more than 13,000 students including more than 3,000 international students from around the world. Finance courses are offered.

Eligibility: Open to KU Business students who have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA. It generally works best for students who have completed their Business Core.

Terms Offered: Fall and Spring

UNIVERSITY OF WOLLONGONG

Wollongong, Australia

The university was founded in 1951 and today has an enrollment of 20,000 students. The international population includes students from more than 70 countries. Wollongong is about 50 miles south of Sydney.

Eligibility: Applicants must be at least a second semester sophomore by the beginning of the program, and have a cumulative GPA of 2.7.

Terms Offered: Fall and Spring

WU VIENNA UNIVERSITY OF ECON. AND BUSINESS

Vienna, Austria

Located in the largest city and capital of Austria, Vienna University of Economics and Business (WU) is amid the hustle and bustle of its urban environment. The university, focusing on business and economics, is the largest in Europe in terms of student body. It has been ranked as one of the best business schools in all of Europe.

Eligibility: : Open to KU students with sophomore standing by the beginning of the program who have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. There is no language requirement; the language of instruction is English.

Terms Offered: Fall, Spring and Summer
